They are also required to share their knowledge with the school community. The participants will be awarded certificates and a membership card from the **Ghana Red Cross Society**

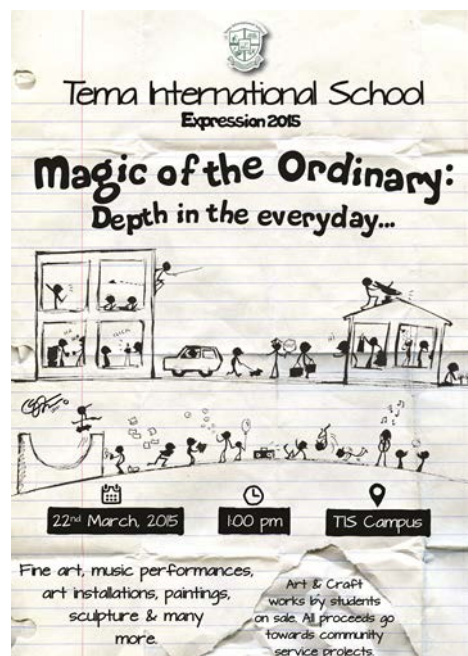
EXPRESSION 2015
