COVID Protocols

Ready for Fast & Furious 18?

The Delta variant is a major concern especially its impact on children and young people. Please note the following changes to our COVID protocols.



1. The test for school must be done 24 hours prior to returning to school and NOT the previous 72 hours since most testing centres, including the suggested Leding and Sonotech, give results within 6-12 hours maximum. This captures most people in the incubation phase who may test negative and start shedding the virus after they get to school.

2. A Day 5 Antigen test will be carried out for all students to ensure that all is well.

3. Teachers, vaccinated and unvaccinated, will be tested every 2 to 4 weeks with the antigen test to pick out any asymptomatic individuals.

4. The mask policy and supervision remain in force. Masks are to be worn at all times, except when having a meal or when students have returned to their individual dorm. Cloth masks are NOT ideal especially due to the ill-fitting nature and worn-out fabric.

5. Vaccination is no more a ticket to freedom with this predominant Delta strain. ALL other protocols will be encouraged and monitored, especially sanitising, temperature checks, opening a window or two, and social distancing at all times.

- Monday, **30 August**, Primary School Campus students commence classes.
- Parents must advise us if their son/daughter will not be returning by 22 August, as these students will be required to quarantine before entering the hostels. In these cases, parents will be advised when the student may return due to quarantine space restrictions.

• Students must have sufficient personal supplies (face masks, sanitiser, sanitising wipes and antiseptic.)

• Parents and students should keep in mind that due to COVID there will be no exeats approved unless due to extenuating circumstances and only with the approval of the General Manager.

We are looking forward to the safe arrival of our 2021 Newbies on 18 August and the safe return of our continuing students on 22 August.






