# CLASS STRUCTURE

The Early Years operate in a standalone building within an openspace learning environment. It comprises several areas within the building so that students can explore, play and learn.

The Junior Primary Classes (Grades 1 - 3) and the Senior Primary Classes (Grades 4 - 6) operate in open flexible learning areas.





# **CURRICULUM**

The Primary School is an authorised IB PYP world school. The application for candidacy was completed by 31 March 2019.

Approval was granted on 14 May 2019, with an effective starting date of 1 September 2019.

The school received official IB PYP authorization in February 2021.



As an authorized PYP School, the PYP framework has been implemented from Day 1, including teachers using ManageBac, our online Learning Management System.

Subjects include Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Arts, and Personal,

Social and Health Education.

However, these subjects will be viewed under the six transdisciplinary themes and concepts. The six themes are:

- who we are;
- where we are in place and time;
- how we express ourselves;
- how the world works;
- how we organize ourselves; and
- sharing the planet.

PYP is driven by seven key concepts which give the inquiries direction and meaning:

- form: what is it like?
- function: how does it work?
- causation: why is it like it is?
- change: how is it changing?
- connection: what is the link to other things?
- perspective: what are the points of view?
- responsibility: what is our responsibility?

These concepts are timeless (factual examples change, but not the core understanding), universal (so students can understandings apply across cultures. situations and disciplines) and abstract (so students engage in higher order thinking to grapple with central ideas).
